AIRCRAFT HISTORY

Originally produced for the Italian
Military operating in Rome training
pilots for the war, post-war the
Caproni was used for skywriting and
advertising for cult brands in Milan.

In the 1990's, it was acquired by its current owner, an Italian businessman and pilot, who over many years managed the restoration of the aircraft to original ex-factory condition, using completely original parts.

Flying this aircraft and its seaplane (1935) equivalent, (recently sold), has been compared to that of playing a Stradivarius. Yet the Caproncino is not overly complicated to fly, and provides a sensorial and thrilling flying experience second to none.

As the Italians say "L'esperienza é mozzafiato" – the experience is breath-taking.

The history is colossal and the opportunity to acquire such an aircraft is rare.
